Respondent: Denton Kimberly

Allegation: Denton Kimberly violated Ala. Code § 34-43-158(a) and Ala. Admin. Code r. 532-X-5-.03(1)(h) for performing massage therapy without a license.

Board Action: Chong S. Yu entered into a Consent Order with this Board regarding the alleged violations and his Massage Therapy license has been surrendered. Mr. Yu is not allowed to reapply for licensure in the State of Alabama for a minimum of three (3) years.
